Dear Parent or Guardian,

Help your child succeed in school – sign up for free tutoring! As a result of the federal *No Child Left Behind Act*, your child can receive extra help in the areas of math, reading, language arts, and science. You can receive free tutoring because your child's school has failed to make adequate yearly progress on state tests for five consecutive years, and your family meets the income limits under the law.

To help you select a free tutoring program that is best for your child, a brochure highlighting approved tutoring programs serving Glenbard East is enclosed. These programs have been approved by the Illinois State Board of Education to provide your child with tutoring that is coordinated with school curriculum.

When deciding what tutoring program is best for your child, you may want to consider these questions:

- When and where will the tutoring take place?
- How often and for how many hours in total will your child be tutored?
- What programs are available to your child?
- What type of instruction will the tutor use?
- What are the tutor's qualifications?
- Can the tutor help if your child has disabilities or is learning English?

If more students request tutoring than can be served through available funding, priority will be given to lowest performing students as determined by the district.
